Our Goals for Student Achievement

School Goals

Our focus will be providing appropriate instruction for all students in order to ensure each student is successful.

Students will become proficient in writing in a variety of genres.

Students will be engaged and learn through hands-on and real life experiences.

First Grade Goals

Our focus in reading will be:

- Read and comprehend text on a level “J”
- Recognize a minimum of 300 sight words
- Write narrative, opinion, and informational pieces with sequence

Our focus in math will be:

- Understand addition/subtraction within 20
- Develop an understanding of place value
- Measure lengths using a variety of objects
- Reason about attributes of shapes and compose/decompose geometric shapes

When teachers, students and families work together, we CAN achieve our goals!

In Our First Grade Classroom

The first grade team will work with students and their families to support students’ success in reading and math. Some of our key connections with families will be:

- Bi-weekly sight word assessments that enable teachers to differentiate word lists for students to work on
- Daily small group instruction on the students’ level
- Use math assessments to regroup students in small group instruction to target specific student needs
- Hands-on learning in all subject areas for student engagement
- Weekly newsletters are sent home informing parents of homework assignments, skills to work on, reading passages, and upcoming events

At Home

LCES parents can support students’ success in reading and math.

- Read every night asking your child comprehension questions about what he or she read.
- If the student struggles with reading, have them "echo" you reading the words.
