## Our Goals for Student Achievement

### School Goals

Our focus will be providing appropriate instruction for all students in order to ensure each student is successful.

Students will become proficient in writing in a variety of genres.

Students will be engaged and learn through hands-on and real life experiences.

### Fourth Grade Goals

Our focus in reading will be:

- Cite evidence for inferences from text
- Understand theme/main idea/plot structure
- Understand narrative voice (1<sup>st</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup>)
- Recognize text parts – scene, stanza, etc.
- Write narrative, opinion, and informational pieces with strong evidence, purposeful organization, transitions, examples, and quotations

Our focus in math will be:

- Develop an understanding of multi-digit multiplication/division
- Develop an understanding of fraction equivalence, addition and subtraction of fractions

## In Our Fourth Grade Classroom

The Fourth Grade team will work with students and their families to support students' success in reading and math. Some of our key connections with families will be:

- Develop year-end reading goals for each student and chart the progress towards the goals each nine weeks. Send home student progress along with strategies for supporting the goals.
- Inform parents of standards that will be taught in reading and math each nine weeks.
- Share strategies for hands-on math practice.

## At Home

LCES parents can support students' success in reading and math.

- Read with your child.
- Regularly ask your child to EXPLAIN HOW he or she arrived at the answer to a question.
- Let your child help measure when cooking so that he or she can have real world experience with fractions.
